AIM: To minimise risk of exposure to COVID-19 for SCIA Staff and Clients

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No illness <u>AND</u> • No known contact with COVID-19 case <u>AND</u> • Have not visited a known hotspot in the last 14 days <u>AND</u> • No household member has visited a known hotspot in in the last 14 days • No household member is current displaying any symptoms of illness 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No illness <u>AND</u> • You have visited a known hotspot in the last 14 days <u>AND</u> • Household member <u>HAS</u> visited a known hotspot in the last 14 days • <u>Household</u> member is displaying symptoms of COVID - 19 <p>Consider safest options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If staff member can the person work from home for 14 days? • For client meeting Consider telephone and video calls as an alternative? • Person should monitor their health carefully for symptoms 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you are displaying any symptoms of illness • You have <u>been</u> exposed to a case of COVID-19 • A household member <u>HAS</u> been exposed to COVID-19 (e.g. school/day care/work) • <u>You have visited a location where the government has directed you to self-isolate for 14 days</u> • <u>Household</u> member has a confirmed case of COVID - 19 <p>Considerations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you or household member is a confirmed COVID-19 case, NO visiting any SCIA site until they have been cleared by medical assessment

NOTE: This is a complex situation that is constantly changing. If you have any concerns about whether you attend a SCIA site or any personal concerns related to your own or a household members' immune status, please do not attend. If you are feeling unwell for any reason, please do not attend a SCIA site.
