The data collected will contribute to ongoing development and improvement in the performance, fit, comfort, function, and aesthetic aspects of currently graduated compression stockings.

**Project:** People with mobility-impairing neurological conditions perspectives about graduated compression stockings to prevent deep vein thrombosis

**Participants:** Adults above 18 with mobility-impairing neurological conditions who use GCS. You will be assigned to a focus group with 4 other participants.

**Eligibility:** Adults above 18 with mobility-impairing neurological conditions and use GCS.

**Activity:** Part 1: Online survey (30 mins), Online focus group (30-45mins); Part 2: Scanning both legs (60mins), pressure measurement (30mins)

**Location:** Part 1 will be conducted online; Part 2 will be conducted on UTS Central Campus

**Total Duration:** 2.5 hours. The activities can be conducted on the same day or separately.

After completing all activities in parts 1 and 2, you will be given a **supermarket gift card of \$50** and an **Uber gift card of \$50** as thanks for your participation.
